RE: Complaint Filed by RGV

Members of the GPUS Accreditation Committee (AC) have continued to review and deliberate issues pertaining to the Green Party of Colorado (GPCO) following a complaint filed with the AC on June 13, 2017. After reviewing documentation and teleconferencing with representatives from both the complainants, Restore Green Values (RGV), and Respondents from GPCO party officers, the AC sent a response to both parties and the GPUS Steering Committee on July 14, 2017. In it, the committee listed several points of concern which members felt should be reasonable and easy to rectify, and noted that members of both RGV and Respondents stated they would be willing to work together to build the GPCO.

Since that time, there has been an escalation of the concerns listed in our initial response. Per the committee's discussion and decision and notification of the chair of the Dispute Resolution Committee (DRC) on August 30, 2017, The Accreditation Committee now requests that this matter now go to the Dispute Resolution Committee.

Members of the Accreditation Committee believe there are individuals on all sides willing to work in good faith, and that going through this process can help create a fair resolution and make GPCO a better functioning party. We believe these problems are not irresolvable.
