Document 3.1.b show the names of people holding office or exercising office since August 2015.

Forum administrator was never an elected office, or even an appointed office. Bill Bartlett created and developed the forum years ago, and that is why he was the principal admin. Somewhere in the evidence there is info explaining that he extended admin access to GPUS Co-chair Andrea Merida in the summer of 2015 when she was helping to arrange the annual meeting.

Forum facilitator is listed in the by-laws as an appointed office, but at the 2015 annual meeting the position of forum administrator was placed on the election ballot. At the 2017 meeting the forum administrator position was not included in the election ballot. So that position is listed either in the block with the elected offices or below with the non-elected forum administrator, depending on the year in question.

The forum admins can delete messages and can give access or cut off access to anything on the forum, so the forum admin has ultimate control over forum communications.
