> Thank you for the Intake Report and Recommendation on the Green Party of Colorado (GPCO) dispute resolution request by the Caucus to Restore Green Values (CRGV). We agree to mediation with a mediator appointed by the Dispute Resolution Committee (DRC) with no pre-conditions by any party to the mediation.

> We understand that as soon as the parties agree to mediation, the DRC will request that the Accreditation Committee put the CRGV complaint on hold during the mediation process. Either party may restart the AC

> process if mediation fails to resolve the issues.

> Our agreement to enter into mediation does not imply that we agree with the PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION or FINDINGS contained in the Intake Report and Recommendation on the Green Party of Colorado (GPCO) dispute resolution request. We believe that most of the PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION is incorrect and biased toward Andrea's perspective. We trust that all of the issues in the CRGV complaint will be addressed in mediation and that mediation will result in a DRC final mediation report that is more accurate and balanced.

> Our agreement to participate in mediation is contingent upon Andrea Merida personally agreeing to the mediation, in writing, to the DRC by the deadline set by the DRC, 9AM PDT, Monday, October 9, 2017. Although Jason Justice and Dave Bell should participate, they were primarily supporters of Andrea who also violated bylaws and some of the ten key values, whereas Andrea was the primary perpetrator of the violations in the complaint.
